

INTERNATIONAL CONSULTATIONS ON BUSINESS AND HUMAN RIGHTS

The Kenya National Commission on Human Rights in partnership with the Institute on Business and Human Rights will be holding an international consultative meeting on business and human rights from 22nd to 23rd May 2008 in Nairobi Kenya. The meeting is one of a number being held around the world to investigate the need for, and possible functions of, a global institute (or network of existing institutions) on Business and Human Rights. This follows the work of those such as Mary Robinson, the Business Leaders Initiative on Human Rights and the UN mandate of Professor John Ruggie. It is a multi-stakeholder process in which all views are welcome. We intend to finish consultations during this year, the 60th Anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

The meeting is hosted by the Kenyan National Human Rights Commission and will include speakers from Kenya and elsewhere in Africa.
